Obituary

W. John Uncles 1939 -2025



A long standing member of The Heraldry Society, although in recent years a lapsed member, John was one of the longest surviving and longest serving officers of The City of Bath Heraldic Society which he actively served as Chairman three times and for many years as Secretary and editor of the *Tabard*.

John was a friendly and ever present face at our meetings and was still in harness as Deputy Chairman when his health suddenly failed earlier this year.

John had wide ranging interests besides heraldry, a deep knowledge of railways, industrial archaeology and a gift for languages.

After a career with Bristol City Council he retired as Lord Mayor's Secretary and City Swordbearer, which was represented in his grant of arms.
